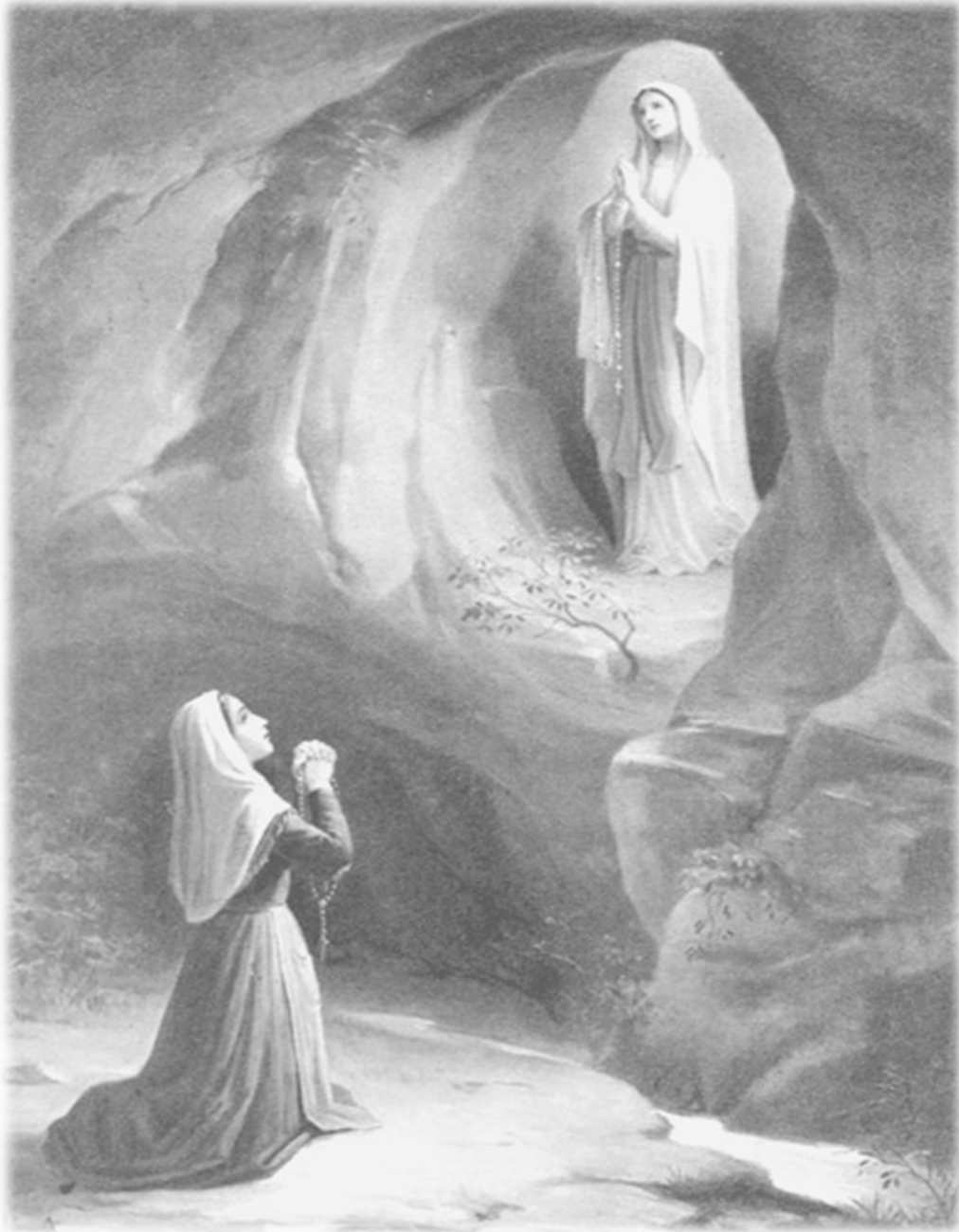

The **Feed Your Faith** group will watch Episode 6 of Season 2 of **The Chosen** this Wednesday, October 6, after our rosary and prayers to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This episode connects beautifully, the incident in 1 Samuel 21: 1-7 where David asks Ahimelech, the high priest of Nob, to give him and his starving men the holy show bread from the Temple (which, of course, is reserved for only priests), with the incident in Mark 2:23-28 where Jesus tells the Pharisees that His men are allowed to pick grains of wheat to eat from a field on the Sabbath. The Pharisees understood His meaning and were horrified—that His Apostles are priest, appointed by Himself, the real high priest.

Our Lady of the Rosary Memorial ~ October 7

The Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary is the reason October is considered the month of the rosary. The feast was established because of an event that took place on Oct. 7, 1571.

That was two years after Pope St. Pius V officially approved the rosary as an approved devotion of the Church. "One of the most famous (and bloodiest) naval battles in history took place that day on the Bay of Lepanto, off the coast of Greece. *PRAY the ROSARY*
