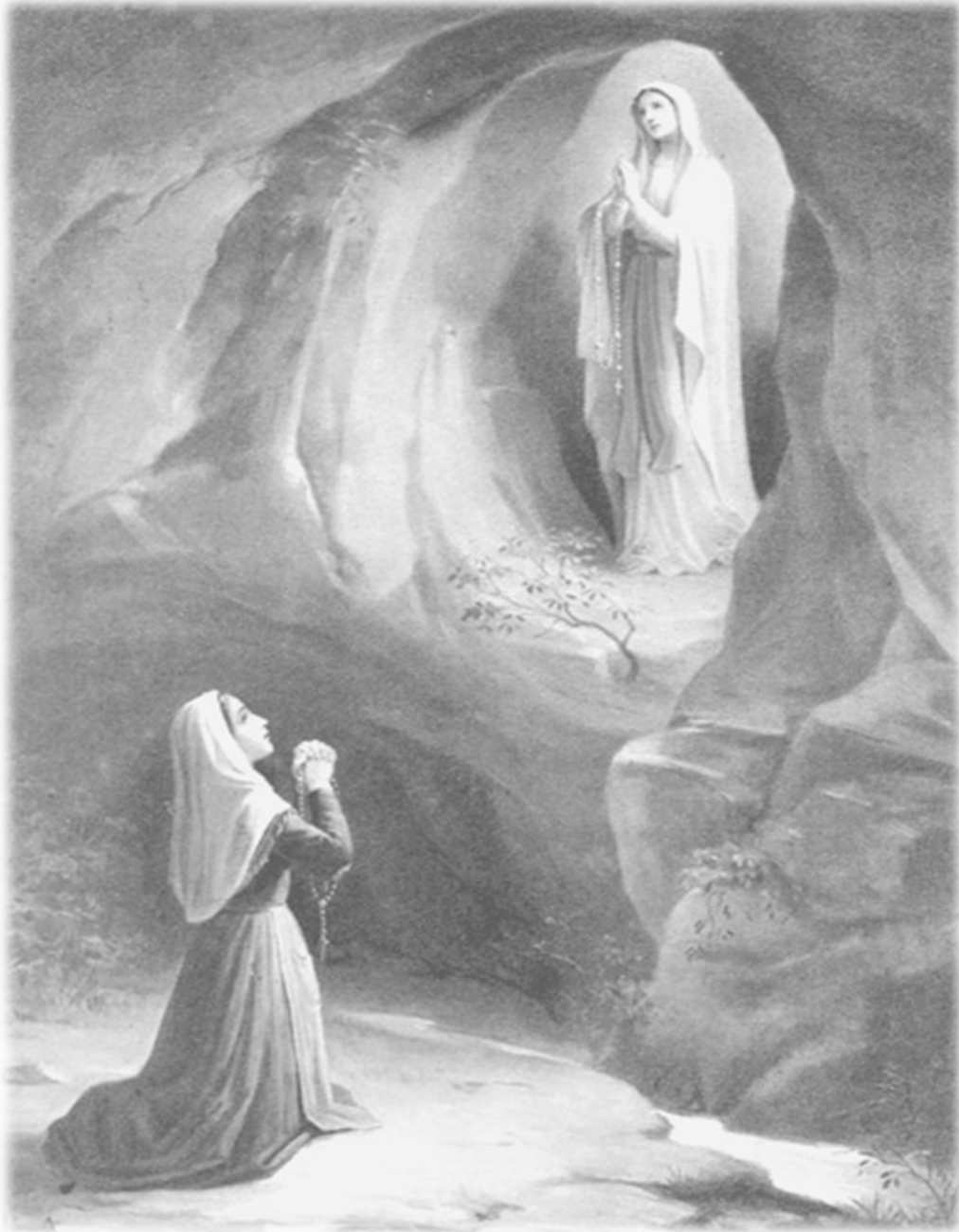

The month of November is a special time to remember all the deceased. We are praying for your beloved deceased, and for all who have died this past year. Praise God, that Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life!

Your prayers are opening many doors here. Most recently, we were contacted by several local Protestant churches interested in Rachel’s Vineyard. Five of the ten recent participants of our last Rachel’s Vineyard retreat for healing after abortion were pastors and pastors’ wives, eager to bring healing to their congregations.

November 18 is becoming a special day to offer prayers in reparation for abortion throughout the world. This initiative started last year in Moscow, led by participants in Rachel’s Vineyard. Soviet Russia was the first country to legalize abortion, on November 18, 1920. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Diocesan Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816.812.2500 or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.
